

To register free for the DACT 'Days-Out' Scheme, simply telephone the number below stating you wish to register as a new member. You will be asked for your full name, address

and date of birth. If you have any kind of mobility difficulties which you think we should be advised of, please notify us. (e.g. you perhaps need to bring a tri-walker or wheelchair on a trip)

Points to note:

- Booking will be on a first-come first served basis
- Unless otherwise stated, price quoted is for return travel only. Food, drink, admission charges etc <u>are not</u> included.
- Payment <u>in cash should be made to the driver on the day of</u> the trip unless stated otherwise.
- Cancellations: Must be made at least 2 working days in advance of the trip. If trips are cancelled at less notice, liability for the cost will be at the discretion of the DACT management.
- DACT will do their best to make sure every trip operates as advertised. However in circumstances beyond our control or minimum numbers not being met, we may have to change or cancel.
- <u>Pick-ups</u> The bus will leave from Daventry Bus Station at the time stated in trip details. If a number of passengers from the same area are travelling, it may be possible to arrange another pick-up point en-route. Passengers can be dropped off at home on the return trip. Carers of wheelchair passengers are welcome to travel at the stated price.
