

The Benefits and Allowances Service What it can provide?

The Benefits and Allowances Service can offer assistance on a practical level.

It aims to support older people and their carers to maintain as independent and as full a life as possible.

We have access to the government's website which contains all the information you may require and can assist you in both learning about benefits and allowances and recent changes and in making an application online or providing the forms you will need to apply by post.

The Benefits and Allowances Service What you can expect?

One of our volunteers from the Benefits and Allowances Service, only at your request, will visit you at home to review what benefits and allowances you are currently receiving, and then determine if any other benefits and allowances are available for you.

There are many changes taking place regarding the State Pension with application for several benefits having to be made online and the raising of the age from which entitlement begins.

We have public access computers available in Okehampton.

The Benefits and Allowances Service Our Goals

The Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) manages most benefits through Jobcentre Plus offices. Benefits and entitlements for pensioners are dealt with through a network of pension centres for those who need additional help and support.

You'll also often deal with other agencies or government departments, such as your local council or HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC).
