Promoting stable marriage and family life

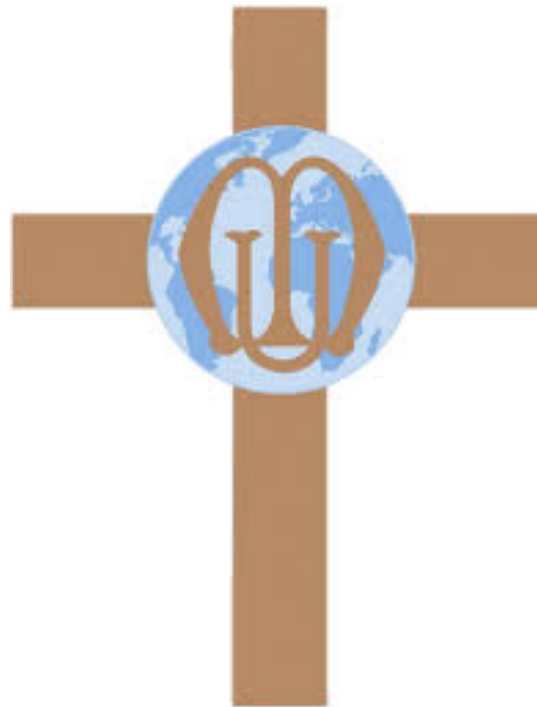
