[E7] Sang up every song that driver [A] knew (Base run) or just strum [A7]



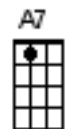
[D] Freedom's just another word for [A] nothin' left to lose

Standin' right beside me through everythin' I done

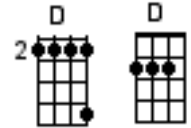
Every night she kept me from the [A] cold
