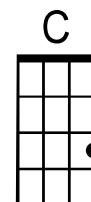


## SINGING THE BLUES (4/4 TIME)

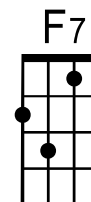
INTRO: (C) (F) (C) (G7) (2 beats each)



VERSE 1:

Well, I (C)never felt more like (F7)singing the blues,

'Cause (C)I never thought that (F)I'd ever (G7)lose your (F)love, dear, (G7)

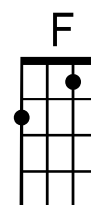


N.C. Why'd you do me this (C)way (F) (C) (G7) (2 beats each)

VERSE 2:

Well, I (C)never felt more like (F7)crying all night

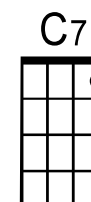
'Cause (C)everythin's wrong, and (F)nothin' ain't (G7)right with-(F)out you, (G7)



N.C. You got me singing the (C)blues (F) (C) (C7) (2 beats each)

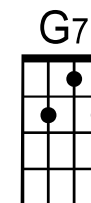
CHORUS:

The (F7)moon and stars no (C)longer shine, the (F7)dream is gone.....



I (C)thought was mine

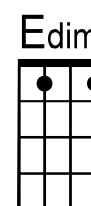
There's (F7)nothing left for (C)me to do but...



N.C. cry-y-y over (G7)you (Edim) (G7)

Well, I (C)never felt more like (F7)running away,

But (C)why should I go 'cause (F)I couldn't (G7)stay with-(F)out you, (G7)



N.C. you got me singing the (C)blues. (F) (C) (G7) (2 beats each)

REPEAT VERSE 2

Well, I (C)never felt more.....

REPEAT CHORUS and finish with:

.....N.C. You got me singing the (C)blues (F) (C) (F) (C) (F) (G7) (C) (2 beats each)

NOTES: The basic strum pattern is **1 2 3&4** where 1, 2, 3, 4 are full down beats and “&” is a half beat up strum. Except where there are only 2 beats between chords changes when it is just 2 full downbeats eg. **1 2.** N.C. = no chords
