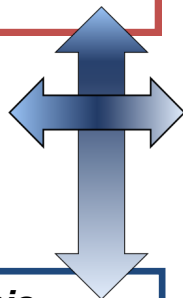

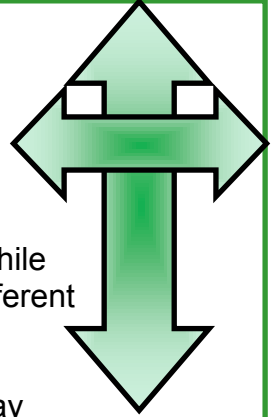
This needs to be a whole Church approach and applications will be invited if it is decided to proceed in this direction
