Empty Plots

It has become an increasing problem that plot holders are going onto empty plots, or plots they think are empty, and helping themselves to items from that plot. Just because a plot has not been worked for sometime does not mean it is vacant the process to remove a plot holder can take up to 2.5 months in the growing season and at this time of the year if they have paid their rent they have until Easter to work their plot. Under no circumstances should plot holders be going onto other plots empty or not without explicit permission. The committee may have rented out an empty plot without your knowledge. If plot holders are found trespassing on other plots this may put their tenancy at risk. Full details on the process of evicting plot holders for non cultivation will be placed on the notice board.
