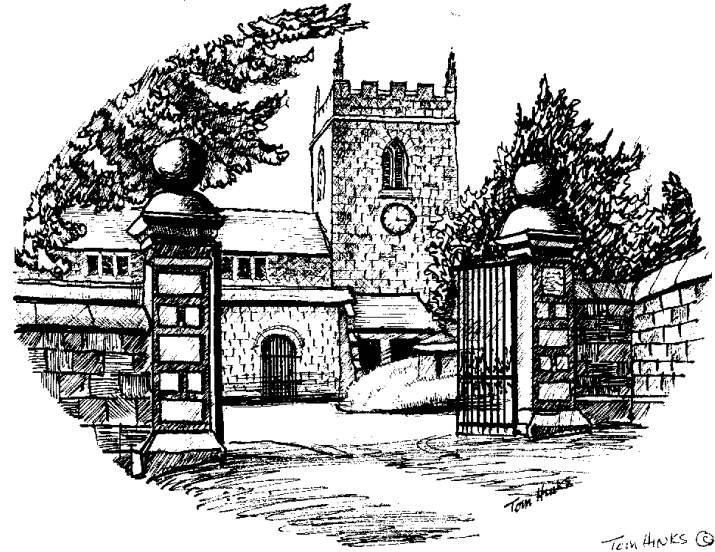




### Services at St. Peter's

## Flowers

- ♥ You are welcome to arrange your own flowers, but please notify the office so that the Church flower arranger can be informed and arrangements made for opening the Church.
- ♥ It may not be possible to arrange your own flowers on Church festivals, e.g. Easter or Harvest. You may wish to contribute flowers to be used in the displays.
- ♥ If silk or dried flowers are used we request that they be removed immediately after the service.



## Candles

If you would like a candle-lit service, the Church will light candles in the windows and chandeliers for you at a cost of £40

## Video

If you or your guests are planning on videoing your service, it is your responsibility to purchase a 'limited manufacture licence'. This is for copyright reasons. This can be applied for on-line at [www.prsformusic.com](http://www.prsformusic.com). Please contact the Parish Office if you would like to see our advice document regarding this or require further advice. Whether a video licence is required for your service may depend upon your choice of music. PRS for Music can also be contacted with any queries on: 0208 378 7500. Following purchase of a licence, PRS will email you this. This can be emailed onto the Parish Office or a print off given. We require sight of the email or print out prior to your service.



## Service Sheets



Our service sheet design can be tailored to your service and printed for you by the office. Prices are at the rate of £50 per 100 black & white, or £75 per 100 for colour, printed on ivory, cream or white special paper. Samples are available for you to look at. If you prefer to produce your own service sheets, the office can help provide the required information, such as the order of service, hymn lyrics and Church pictures. It is important for copyright reasons that service sheets acknowledge the following for all songs played: 1. Author, 2. Year, 3. Owner, 4. Our Church Copyright Licence reference: CCL 1000462

## Confetti

We ask that the Confetti used is bio-degradable and not made of foil.



## Finance

The cost of your service will be discussed at your Preparation meetings. The fees for a Wedding Blessing or Renewal of Vows Service taking place in 2016, is £226. In addition to this there may be additional costs relating to the service and the arrangements that you would like for this, including a vergers (£30), an organist (£60), heating (£20, Sept to May season), choir (where available, £100), bells (where available, £150), candle-lit service (£40), and service sheets if you would like the Office to produce these (prices vary depending upon number of copies and whether black & white or colour design chosen).

***\*Please note that all costs are for the current year and are subject to review on an annual basis.\****

## Car Parking



There is no car park at St. Peter's. Cars can be parked in the lane but this is limited. You may wish to make an arrangement with the publican in the village pub, "The Red House". He may be willing, especially if it brings in some custom!
