## **Courrier Report**

The following are snippets of information which have been reported in recent weeks in the Courier du Loiret....

Pithiviers in National Press - Pithiviers featured in the national press when 43 students traveling on the school bus were apprehended for not wearing seat-belts. It appears that, without warning, a police officer boarded the bus and all students not wearing seat belts were charged, resulting in a combined fine of  $\varepsilon$ 135 – and lots of very unhappy parents!

Gazelles seek sponsorship - two young women from Pithiviers, Imane Bouchama and Mabel Sierra Medina are currently looking for sponsorship to help fund their intended participation in the 23rd edition of the prestigious Rallye Aïcha des Gazelles. This entirely off-road Rally in Southern Morocco consists of one prologue and six legs, two of which are two-day marathon legs. A total of 2,500 kilometers through dried-out river beds, shock absorber-busting stony plains and the sandy dunes of the western Sahara desert have to be covered by the teams with only a compass and a 1:100,000 scale map to plot their route between checkpoints. GPS, binoculars and cell phones are forbidden. Taking place from 16<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> March 2013, it differs in two fundamental ways from most car rallies. Firstly, the winner is not the fastest team but the one which travels the least distance between checkpoints within a given time frame and secondly, all teams are 100% female!

Building headache for businesses – public buildings and others which permit access to the public are currently planning how to make the necessary alterations to satisfy new access laws which come into force in 2015. By that date, all buildings, including shops, which are open to the public, must be accessible equally to all people, including those in wheelchairs.....but don't hold your breath as the date has already been pushed back from 2011 due to the enormity of the task and expense of satisfying the new requirements.
