


Attendance at this event on Saturday 13th September was, to say the very least. disappointing. It was intended to be our major fundraiser this year but, instead lost money!

## THE 2015 TRIP TO PITHIVIERS

As previously indicated and following a general survey of members it has been decided next year to follow the example of our French friends and take an extra day for the visit, leaving on Wednesday 17th June and staying overnight at a hotel in northern France. This would enable us to make a visit on Thursday morning before going on to Pithiviers. Nothing is yet firmly decided but as 17th June, 2015 marks the exact 200th anniversary of the Battle of Waterloo we are looking into the possibility of making a visit there for what will, undoubtedly be serious celebrations to mark this momentous event in European history.

Obviously there will be additional costs and we have endeavoured to calculate this (as far as is possible without knowing exact numbers). As it will be necessary to make a commitment to a hotel as well as the coach company we must also ask for a commitment from members to the tune of £30 per traveller as a non-refundable deposit and hope you will understand this necessity at this early date in terms of calculating the viability of this new format. As usual we recommend each traveller to make the necessary insurance arrangements in case of the need to cancel because of illness.

There is a booking form on the back page to be returned with the deposit. Based on the modest increase in coach fare over the price we paid in 2013 and assuming there will be approximately the same number of people, the total cost is likely to be in the region of £200. You will be asked to pay the balance nearer to the time of the visit. All figures are necessarily approximate and depend on the number of travellers.
