She thanked her fellow officers and executive committee members for their continued support and briefly outlined the various social and fundraising events as well as details of this year's eventful visit to Pithiviers.

Treasurer, Peter Wilkinson submitted his report confirming the present healthy state of funds but sounding the warning that this year had not been the most successful for fundraising and highlighting the need to raise important sums if we were to maintain our traditional level of hospitality for the visit of our friends from Pithiviers every other year. Given the increase in subscription rate agreed at last year's AGM, it was accepted that the annual subscription next year would remain unaltered.

Anne Donegan, the Membership Secretary reported on the current membership position, which, despite some new members, has not altered significantly over the year.
