BILL PRATT

In the early hours of Tuesday 26th January Bill Pratt, our Honorary President, passed away. This is really the end of an era. Although not a founder member of the Association, he joined in the very early days and for a long time worked closely with John Staples, the moving spirit behind it. Bill was, in many ways, the very embodiment of the Twinning. Serving in several rôles, including that of chairman, he represented us on many occasions, like the Annual Parish Meeting and Remembrance Sunday and it is difficult to recall a visit to or from Pithiviers without him there (his

distinctive beret even acknowledged by a French mayor!). For many years he recorded the visits, first with his camera, then on video camcorder. Several of them are in our website archive.

But Bill was also well known about town through his pioneering involvement with Ivanhoe College - the first



community college in Leicestershire. He was often approached by ex-pupils, remembered him fondly.

Bill loved to travel. As a young man he went, alone, to Paris just before the second world war. Thereafter there appeared to be no limit! He and Nita lived for a while in the USA as part of an educational exchange. They travelled widely in the Soviet Union, visited China and were fond of German river cruises, in which he still indulged, well into his nineties. He made friends in many countries and kept in touch with them.

Bill was truly a pillar of the Association in which he inevitably leaves a large gap. We will miss him and our heart-felt sympathy goes out to Nita and William at this sad time of loss.

The funeral is at Holy Trinity Church at 15:00, Thursday 4th February then to Bretby Crematorium.
