He has clearly researched it in great detail and was able to regale us with many facts and anecdotes about the famous vessel and its sister ships, Olympic and Britannic, many of which, despite the celebrity of the ship and the

tragic events for which it has become infamous over the last 100 years or so were quite new to us or upon which he was able to shed new light.

The tale was interrupted at the moment of impact of the notorious iceberg to permit a break for refreshments in the form of a buffet of cheese, paté, etc. and a glass of wine with the usual raffle after which Jake took up the story of the actual sinking and its aftermath. It really was a revealing and, indeed, entertaining evening that went down well!
