# THE 2019 TRIP TO PITHIVIERS

Once again we will be taking an extra day for the visit, leaving on Wednesday 5th June and staying overnight at an hotel in France. This would enable us to leave later in the morning and visit somewhere interesting on Thursday en route to Pithiviers. Nothing is yet firmly decided but we are currently researching some options.

Obviously there will be additional costs and we have endeavoured to calculate this (as far as is possible without knowing exact numbers). As it will be necessary to make a commitment to an hotel as well as the coach company we must also ask for a commitment from members to the tune of £30 per traveller as a non-refundable deposit and hope you will understand this necessity. As usual we recommend each traveller buy the necessary insurance in case of the need to cancel because of illness.

A booking form is below to be returned to Margaret with deposit <u>as quickly as possible</u>. Based on quoted coach fare and assuming approximately the same number of people as last time, the total cost is likely to be in the region of £350. You will be asked to pay the balance nearer to the time of the visit. All figures are necessarily approximate and depend on the number of travellers.
