#### **Subscription Fee Arrangements for New Members**

The Executive Committee agreed the following new bylaw which comes into force with immediate effect.

"A pro rata rate for new members' first year of membership will be applicable whereby they will pay 100% of the annual subscription rate if joining between Sept and Dec; 80% if joining between Jan and Apr and 50% if joining between May and August. Their membership will then be subject to renewal on 1st September."
