We have now submitted our response to the planning application for the anaerobic digester at Frogmary Green Farm after SSDC asked for any further comments. We pointed out that the site developer, Greener for Life, had not provided the information we required and that the matters raised in our letter of October 2015 remained unanswered. As a result, Lopen Parish Council was (and remains) unable to consider the application further until such time as the members have been provided with information adequate to make a recommendation.

Transparency fund

As a result of legislation requiring parish councils to publish various documents on a website, the Government has made funds available to councils to buy a computer and the necessary equipment. We made a successful application and Roger has now used the money to equip us with a laptop and a replacement printer/scanner which should fulfil our IT requirements.

Parish Ranger (Barry Davolls writes:)

What do the Parish Rangers do for us? Well pretty much anything we ask for that relates to village maintenance.

Our limited budget provides a Ranger for only 7.4 hours per month (and this is halved over the winter months) which limits the extent of maintenance that can be achieved.



In the main, the Ranger is routinely tasked to maintain the publicly owned areas within the village, some work on the Lopen Head roundabout and Islands, keeping the boundary markers clear and tidy, leaf and litter clearance, one-off tasks as they become necessary in other areas of the village and, in exceptional cases, some public footpath maintenance. We do not usually ask the Ranger to maintain the verges where they are closely related to private properties as in the main, these are taken care of by the dwelling occupants (and sometimes enhanced - thank you). Maintenance of public footpaths and drains are avoided as much as possible as responsibility for these (and therefore the cost) sits with Somerset County Council.



John Milner would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience this charity fundraiser might cause. It is difficult to estimate the likely numbers attending. Thanks to their generosity, however, parking space has been arranged in Ben Norton's field on the main road and in John Pitcher's field in School Lane.
