

GMP AND THE COMMUNITY

BURGLARS ARE OPERATING IN YOUR AREA 1 in 3 burglaries occur due to an open/unlocked window or door

PLEASE REMEMBER TO LOCK UP – update your security, remove keys from view, secure doors and windows, use house alarms and consider fitting CCTV. A number of sheds have been broken into in the area, try and minimise the number of garden entrances and install heavy lockable gates that cannot be seen through. Make your garden a challenge to get into then many thieves won't bother. One of the commonest ways thieves break into sheds is by popping the roof off so bolt it to the frame, buy the best padlock you can for the door and change the hinges to coach bolts. Ensure pedal cycles are secured to the floor install a shed alarm and obtain insurance



Drivers of Goods Vehicles please be aware of the Windlehurst Road Weight Restriction Goods vehicles

exceeding a gross weight of 7.5T are **prohibited** on Windlehurst Road between High Lane and Marple.

Stockport Anti-Social Behaviour Fund have agreed to fund 12 months of boxing sessions each Friday evening between 6pm – 7pm at Magic Hattons Boxing Gym, Pear Mill, Stockport.



There are further opportunities to train with another boxing club, Paramount ABC, also based at Magic Hatton's gym at Pear Mill where training takes place every Monday, Wednesday and Friday night between 7 and 8.30pm. The cost per session is £3.50 and again this is a non-profit club with all proceeds put back into the gym. Their 22 registered boxers represent the club in competitions all over the North West but also cater for people who just want to train and get involved in a disciplined and healthy lifestyle. 

Oldknow Road junction of Stockport/Strines Road B6101 You MUST NOT stop or park on: 'a road marked with double white lines, even when a broken white line is on your side of the road, except to pick up or set down passengers or to load or unload goods'

You could be liable for 3 points and a fine

'Open Your Eyes to Knives'

The legal consequences:

Do something positive - You can live knife free

Are the people you surround yourself with having a positive impact on your life – friends should never pressure you into doing something you don't want to do - try to think of a way to say no - it could save your life.
