Situated in the village of the Pludds above Ruardean the hall is a wooden single story building set in pleasant surroundings. It features good car parking and has disabled access. Facilities comprise:-

- 1) A large function room of 105 sq meters, with a standing capacity of 150 persons standing and 100 seated. This hall has a wooden floor. Five electric heaters provide adequate heating.
- 2) An entrance lobby of 45 sq mts capacity 35 seating 45 standing.
- 3) A small committee room measuring 30 sq mts capacity 25 standing and 20 seated. This room has recently been refurbished and is now a comfortable carpeted room suitable for small meetings or other purposes for smallish groups.

We have 20 tables and in excess of 100 seats available.

Toilet facilities include those for the disabled.

Kitchen facilities

Hot water supply, four ring electric oven and also gas rings as well as a small microwave. A tea urn is also provided.

The committee is very active and under the stewardship of the previous chairman has completed the renovation of the exterior of the building as well as the above mentioned committee room. The renovation of the exterior involved renewal of joists and flooring in some areas, the replacement of cladding and insulation, fitting of double glazing and the renewal of fire doors.

Currently we are raising funds for the refurbishment of the kitchen.

FEES

We charge £4.50 per hour for the hire of the hall

For parties and wedding receptions the charge is £6.00 per hour, minimum payment is £60.00.
