The **Dunsden Hall Community Lottery** is a regular way of donating to Dunsden Village Hall to ensure it continues to be an attractive venue for community and family events. The lottery will help to raise funds for improvements and for the general upkeep of the fabric of the hall.

What's in it for you?

Each month there will be **3** winning numbers drawn with cash prizes of **£30, £10 and £10***. A lucky number costs just **£15 per year** with draws taking place each month.

Our aim is to sell 100 numbers, but we can maintain this level of prizes if 80 lucky numbers are sold.

RULES:

- * A draw will be held each month from October to September, on **21st of the month**. Draws will take place at Binfield Heath Stores on, or around, the 21st of the month or at a fundraising event near that date.
- * If we sell 80 numbers there will be 12 monthly draws with prizes of £30, £10 and £10.
- * If fewer than 80 tickets are sold, the Trustees reserve the right to award only a 1st prize, or a 1st & 2nd prize.
- * All matters requiring adjudication shall be determined by the trustees of Eye & Dunsden Hall, whose decision on all matters regarding the administration of the lottery shall be final.
