Two gentle men came to the door last Monday morning. They told me they knew I would be busy (how did they know?) and perhaps was not interested in religion (how did they know?) but they thought I would be glad to know that the Bible would answer any questions I had.

I thanked them for calling and they said they would return if I wanted them to and gave me a leaflet with a contact address.

The whole event took less than a minute. I spoke only two words "Thank you" and their rehearsed little speech took the rest of the minute. Smiling pleasantly, they went.

Would you do that for your Catholic faith? Knock on door after door, smile pleasantly, give someone a holy picture and go?

Have you ever shared your faith with a stranger? Has a stranger ever shared faith with you? What is the magic/mystery of being able to share faith? If we knew, every good parent would be glad to know, every priest would long for the gift, every teacher in religious education would want that blessing. Is there an answer?

Role models? I don't believe in role models. They are simply people who already do what we want to do. Do you know a single person who became a Christian because a film star, a pop star, a famous footballer was a Catholic? Our gracious Queen Elizabeth goes to church regularly, our former Prime Minister, Tony Blair, became a Catholic, our inspiring Pope Francis calls the Falkland Islands the Malvinas. Is anyone inspired to think or act as those three do? Are they role models?

Do you vote for the Christian or Catholic candidate in elections? Are you impressed by boxers or runners or footballers who bless themselves in front of the crowds? Would you? Perhaps you could bless yourself as you take your shopping trolley down the supermarket aisles, as you get on a bus or enter the place where you work . . .

Would your role model have approved of dropping the atom bombs on Hiroshima and Nagazaki, want to retain Trident to destroy millions of innocent people if their evil governments attack us first? I should have asked the Jehovah Witnesses what they thought. But would I have taken any notice?

God bless us in our search for truth.
