Dear People,

Do you wish we had had a referendum on same-sex marriage in this country, as the people in Ireland were able to have? No need, you might say, because we would know the result before ever we voted. The Government did not need to consult us.

But the Irish Government could easily have passed such a bill without consulting the people - all the political parties were in favour of a "Yes" vote. It seems the Irish government had a second agenda: to show the Catholic Church that it had lost its position of influence. We knew how the vote would go but had to wait to discover the margin.

We pray for the people of the Church in Ireland. They have gone through a painful period and we are shocked at the inadequacy of the Church's response to the terrible abuse we now know about. We pray above all for the healing of those who were hurt and for full justice to be done for them.

We shall soon have a referendum in this country about the European Union. Already, we are told, the framing of the actual question is proving difficult: should we remain or should we leave? If the recent election had returned a Labour/Lib-Dem government there would have been no referendum. Are you glad we are to be trusted or there is a political game here? If Labour/Lib-Dem had claimed there was no need for a referendum, but we should trust the elected government, there would not have been one.

So why is the Tory government giving us a voice? I'm glad, always, when referenda are allowed by governments, because they are a sign that we are a free people; but I'm also concerned that it may reflect a lack of trust in our elected government. But, I answer myself, an elected government is always a minority of the voting public. More people, in our democracy, have voted against the government and not for it . . . .

Should we have referenda on Trident and nuclear weapons (possession of, use of), on abortion, capital punishment, assisted dying . . .

The government can decide what is legal, it does not decide what is moral. Morality belongs to the people and we must be free to make moral choices. In our democracy, we are, thank God.

May God guide us in our moral lives and help us to be good citizens.
