# How we can help AgeUK

- (1) Shops: there are 24 shops around the city. AgeUK will collect large items but we can drop in smaller ones ourselves: Tel.2992233
- (2) Volunteer your Time: whether you want to help for an hour a week or three days a week AgeUK will find you a role: Tel.2992233
- (3) Run your own FUNdraising events plenty of suggestions available: Tel.2237344

A couple of years ago AgeUK researched with local older people what they perceived would be their challenges in later life. The issues they raised, perhaps unsurprisingly, were around not being a burden on family, not feeling lonely or isolated, having support to help them stay living in their own home and having services which were responsive to their needs.

They hit the nail on the head with that last wish as the research was developed how services needed to develop to meet evolving need. AgeUK continues to begin new projects and the latest one is the Personal Assistant service through which clients may want some help with bills and paperwork, a trip to the shops, or a hand in clearing out cupboards, etc.

Our SVP does similar work in the parishes. You may like to be and feel involved. Please think and pray about it. We have much to offer and we know there are many needs.
