Dear People,

I lose. Have you noticed the reduction in the numbers of the Catholic papers? I became too disappointed with the numbers left over each week that I reduced the order and cancelled the Catholic Times because not one copy had been sold over a month. Yet it is part of our faith to grow in knowledge and understanding so I remind you there is good reading available on the tables at the back of church and in our excellent Watermead Shop (at the top of the car park). Do look. The books come from the Prayer Trust, founded by my friend Fr Pat Sayles.

Tertullian was writer in the early Church. He tells us what a spiritual offering to God prayer is. "The hour is at hand when genuine worshippers will worship God in spirit and in truth - and we are genuine if we pray from a devoted heart, from faith and the living of a good life."

St Peter Chrysologus speaks of prayer, fasting and mercy that sustain our faith. Prayer knocks at God's door, fasting wins us what we need, and mercy is the hand that stretches out to help.

These two saints are in the readings for last week that form part of the priests' daily prayer - 'The Breviary' which contains prayer for every part of the day. Would you like to share in that form of prayer, every part of the day having its blessing from God? Look at the tables at the back of church and see a wide range of small books of prayer (20p each) that might satisfy you at least for a while. If they do, you will then want to explore more widely the ways of prayer until you come to the simple way that is opening your heart and mind to God without need of others' words. Then you can pray all day, everywhere.

St Theophilus (a wonderful name that means "someone who loves God") tells us that, if we wish, God will cleanse our eyes and then we shall see more clearly, as God does. That is, for him, the inspiration of prayer - to come close to God so that we may come close to others in God's love. St Theo seems to think this is a blessing available to all of us.

Do not think the advice of saints is beyond you. They were like us and we can become like them - but we have to want to.


