Our Year of Faith draws to its close. I hope you feel enriched by all that has been happening and especially that you followed the suggestions given each week at the head of our Parish Week column in the newsletter.



A cluster of parishes in the northern part of our diocese wanted to end the Year of Faith with a pilgrimage to Rome and asked if we would organise it for them through Watermead. It was a wonderful week. Three times we saw Pope Francis who spoke beautifully and with good humour each time. The crowds in St Peter's Square were large (even 80,000 for the Angelus on Sunday!). Each time he gave us his blessing we were reminded that the blessing was also for everyone at home, especially for the sick and housebound. All of us blessed by Pope Francis . . .

Four times we had mass in St Peter's and other times at the Vatican church of St Anne's and the parish church of Our Lady's, and we were made welcome at both churches. Church Rome, Ancient Rome, the historical city - we saw so much.

So our new parish year begins as the Year of Faith ends. Someone told me recently what a good parish St Joseph's is - strong finance team, active hall committee, charity and fundraising support, hospitality teams, reverent sacristy team, altar ministers and servers, thorough cleaning team, nimble-fingered garden team. apostolic SVP society, good musicians and singing on Saturdays and Sundays, a fine shepherdesses children's liturgy group, a group of careful counters - and a friendly welcoming atmosphere. I was told how fortunate I was. Thank you, everyone. The whole parish is grateful for what you do.

Lynn and our children's liturgy are beginning a new fundraising Advent project for our friends at Mother of Peace in Zimbabwe - "In the Beak Midwinter". Sounds fun - see over the page.
