Dear People,

It has been a wonderful parish Christmas, full of love, sadness, sympathy and joys. There have been so many to remember with gratitude that we knew and loved them, that they are at peace with God and that we remember them still, even though always with sadness.

On behalf of the parish I thank all those who help the life of the parish to flow so well. Both our churches looked beautiful, but they always do; the music and singing were as inspiring as ever, the serving so accomplished and the reverence at mass as ever. The work of the parish - sacristy, cleaning, maintenance, decoration, administration, hall, garden - all in capable hands and how grateful we are.

We look forward to a new year of blessings, prayer and effort. Sadly, a new effort has been brought to our attention by the Society for the Protection of the Unborn Child (SPUC). On 17th December the Supreme Court issued a ruling which left our Glasgow midwives shocked and saddened.

Connie and Mary have always refused to supervise abortions. They have twenty years experience in the labour wards and have helped to deliver around 10,000 babies. However, today it is common for late abortions to be performed in hosptial labour wards. In its ruling the court said the midwives can still refuse to perform abortions, but senior midwives must asign junior midwives to conduct the process and be ready to oversea abortions. Connie and Mary believe that as abortion itself is wrong it is also wrong to ask junior midwives to do an abortion.

The Supreme Court ruling also applies to doctors and nurses. They must be willing to make bookings for abortions and help in other ways. The ruling strikes a blow against all pro-life people in the health care professions.

This is our country, our society and our world. We all have a conscience and before God want to live according to our consciences. We pray that in 2015 we will know how to speak and act. May God guide us in our pro-life work so that the beauty of the unborn child will be seen.


