Dear People,

Lourdes was wonderful. We arrived for the evening meal and then made our way to the Domaine for the Torchlight Procession (every evening at 9 pm). We joined in the prayer of the thousands gathered to honour Our Lady and then returned to our comfortable hotel St Louis de France.

On Friday we walked together to the Domaine. A warm sunny day. I gave a guided tour - Crowned Virgin, the Saints of the Sanctuary and I told their stories: Ss Remi, Vincent de Paul, Joachim and Anne, Roch, Bernard, John the Baptist, John the Evangelist, Hyacinth, Louis de Montfort, Martin. Then to the Grotto and the silence, always, of hundreds of people at prayer. Only when there is mass does anyone speak in the Grotto area.

We went on to the Baths, across the River Gave and along the far bank to the Blessed Sacrament Chapel, the large diocesan halls for mass and conferences, and then across the bridge to the Grotto area. It was 11.30 am and we spent the time before lunch revisiting and exploring where we chose. After lunch we had a couple of hours to browse before mass at 4.00 pm, Blessed Sacrament Procession at 5.00 pm, Supper at 7.00 pm and Rosary and Torchlight Procession at 9.00 pm.

On Saturday we walked through the town, visiting the places where Bernadette and her family lived in years of poverty: the Cachot (Prison house), Rue du Bourg, the parish church where she was baptised, Maison Paternelle and the Boly Mill where she was born. It is a sad story as background to the wonder of a little girl being chosen by Our Lady.

Some of us became members of the choir that sang and led the prayer for the Torchlight Processions and the singing and music for the International Mass at the Underground Basilica - 15,000 of us for a beautiful celebration.

So those were our days: breakfast 7-9.30 am, visiting and praying in the Basilicas, Stations of the Cross, at the Grotto; lunch 12-1.30 pm, mass at 2.00 pm, Blessed Sacrament Procession at 5.00 pm. Supper at 7.00 pm, Torchlight Procession at 9.00 pm. "It's tiring being a Lourdes pilgrim," said Ian.

We were such a good group, easy with each other, sharing everything. Lourdes is wonderful. We lit our candles for families and friends and I lit one for the parish. So you were all there. Do come next time (the cost is very reasonable).

Christine of our parish has lived in Lourdes for many years. She joined us for mass each day and introduced us to some of her friends, Dora, Kim and Josephine. She sends her greetings to everyone she knows.

I feel grateful to have shared the prayer of Lourdes once again. The days were full of blessings.
