Dear People,

Do you remember Pope Francis' asking every Catholic parish in the world to provide a home for a refugee family? I asked if we could raise £150 per week to cover the rent for a family in need - 15p per week from each of us. A number of you agreed it was something we could/should do.

I took our parish resolution to Churches Together in Humberstone and they wanted to take part. We contacted Leicester City of Sanctuary for advice which was, at first, to wait: so many regulations needed to be considered; but, finally, Ben Brown from One Roof came to speak to the committee of CTH this last week about local needs.

He saw all homeless, refugees and asylum seekers as people in need and asked us to do the same. He spoke of: (1) need for houses to rent; (2) provision of food and meals; (3) emotional support by being willing to befriend those given shelter but still very lonely.

The churches could help by providing rent, paying for food and being willing to visit. The ideal blend for social housing was to be alongside private housing to give a sense of neighbourliness. The Evington churches are paying the rent for a house they found locally available. Could we do the same?

I told Ben of our land at the Rosary church. Might the diocese approve the building of a blend of social and private houses? The site is good - near the shops and buses, the fine green across the road. The parish would be involved through the church and some our elderly parishioners might be glad to rent/buy a house so conveniently placed.

A housing association is to be approached. The diocese will decide but our opinions will be valuable. Please be critically interested - we want to do something good and do it well.

Meantime, back at the ranch, we shall start our weekly retiring collections which will constantly remind us of our people in need. Please feel free to contribute. 50p per week from each of us would pay the rent for two houses. Pope Francis will be delighted.
