Dear Fellow Parishioners,

It is hard to appreciate that it is a year since we last appealed for your ever generous support for the work of St Joseph's SVP Conference. And here we are again!

Our Conference continues its work in the parish with five full members plus one auxiliary and new members are always welcome.

Most of our time is spent visiting parishioners and others who are sick, invalided or housebound and supports Fr John and our Eucharistic Ministers who take Holy Communion to them. Many of our people are in care homes and this continuing link with their parish is a great comfort to them.

Last year we made 24 visits to families in need, 322 visits to elderly housebound parishioners, 375 residential and blind home visits, 4 hospital visits and 168 visits to those suffering from mental illness and dementia.

As we ask for your support once again, recent events give this year's collection a special urgency.

As you will know, recent floods in Kerala have devastated many areas and left thousands homeless. Our four SVP twinned conferences are all in Kerala and they will be trying to help flood victims in their respective parishes. We cannot imagine the hardships these people are facing and St Joseph's SVP will try to send extra financial aid to them.

Thank you once again and God bless you for your unfailing support for the work of the conference.
