Dear People,

You have heard of Pax Christi, the international Catholic movement for peace, and its work over the years. When Bishop Malcolm was first appointed one of his positions was to be patron of Pax Christi.

Their latest newsletter is as interesting as ever. At a conference last October, the Grand Mufti of Bosnia made a moving speech reflecting on his birthplace, Sarajevo, and the history of killing in Europe since the beginning of World War I. He urged people to remember that every human being is blessed with God's spirit and warned against the hypocrisy of countries, producing vast amounts of arms yet stating that they themselves are against arms.

The Conference was given details of unmanned ariel vehicles (UAVs) - one of the fastest growing developments in modern warfare - "drones" they are normally called (and the conference was told that Leicester has a factory where some of these drones are made). Cluster bombs, whose terrible impact can last for many years on the civilian population, were also part of the conference discussions.

Although the power of trade in arms is great, so is the determination and hope of good people to bring about peace, and the "Gothenburg Process" is seen as a powerful forum for those wishing to be involved.
