Dear People,

Last week the Government announced new measures regarding gangs and troublesome youngsters in our streets. You may be interested to read St John Bosco - who would offer interesting ideas and comments on asbos and gangbos:

"How often in my long life I've had to learn and relearn the great truth. It is much easier to get angry than to be patient, to threaten a child than to persuade him. Our impatient pride prefers to punish the headstrong rather than to correct them with firm and tender patience. I urge upon you the example of St Paul's love for his new converts; his love led him to tears and prayer when they were less than docile and resisted him.

"Let no one be able to charge you with acting in anger. It is indeed difficult to punish while remaining calm, but we must manage it or raise suspicion that we act to show our authority or to vent our spleen. Be like Jesus who came not to command but to obey and to be of service. Be ashamed even to appear domineering.

"In difficult circumstances, pray humbly to God rather than pour out words that offend the hearer and do the guilty no good."

St John Bosco spent all his life in the education and guidance of young boys. Do you think he was too idealistic?
