

Directions to Grey College.


From the North (A1M)

Exit at Junction 62, A690 to Durham. You will travel down a dual carriageway for 1.5 miles. At the roundabout, go straight ahead towards the City Centre. You will go down a hill. Stay in the left hand lane and just before the next roundabout, take the left filter lane. The Marriott Royal County Hotel is on your left. Go straight ahead at the traffic lights. Move into the right hand lane and filter slightly right up the hill. You will come to a cross roads with traffic lights. The New Inn is on your left. Go straight through the traffic lights and up the hill. Grey College is the second left turn. Car parking is both in front of and following the road to the left, behind the reception block.

From the South (A1M)

Stay on the A177 for about 5 miles and crossing the River Wear travel to the next island. Turn left and in 1/2 mile turn left at traffic lights, the New Inn is on your right.. Grey College is the second left turn. Car parking is both in front of and following the road to the left, behind the reception block.

Exit at the junction for Horsley & Haddon-on-the-Wall


From the East (A69)

51 Years of Beekeeping Conventions

The first North of England Beekeeping Convention was held at Kirkley Hall in 1956, where they were held every year until 2004 (exception for 2001 when foot and mouth disease intervened). Convened by the beekeepers of Northumberland, Newcastle, Durham, and Cleveland, they are renowned for their friendliness and comradeship. They have always sought to engage speakers of international as well as national stature and this year is certainly no exception. Following the positive response received regarding the change of venue we have decided to meet again this year at Grey College, in Durham.

The University of Durham Botanic Garden is situated near Grey College and as guests of the College, you are free to wander there as you please. The nearby Oriental Museum is also well worth a visit, as are numerous places of interest within the City of Durham, in particular the Cathedral and the Castle.

Please come and join us in Durham this year and help to contribute to our annual beekeeping fellowship, we feel sure you will not be disappointed.

The Sunday Microscopy Workshop will be held in the entomology laboratory at Close House in the beautiful setting of woods and parkland about a mile west of Heddon-on-the-Wall.

OUR SPEAKERS

Dr. David Aston NDB.
David is the First Director of Vodaphone and started his career in 1982. He runs between 10 and 15 events a year.

Davie lives in the Last Runing of Tonsline and started beekeeping in 2002. He runs between 10 and 15 colonies.

His book (co-authored with his wife Sally) titled 'Plants and Honeybees-their relationships' won a Bronze medal at the 2005 Apimondia. He is advisory Science editor for the Beekeepers' Quarterly magazine published by Northern Bee Books.

June Hughes June has been associated with beekeeping for about 27 years. She and her husband run 14 colonies of bees. She started working with beeswax 25 years ago after persuading her husband to make her a solar wax extractor. Though the final straining proved the main challenge she has settled on using absorbent lint and says "this really does take out the fine impurities". She has "won many prizes locally, county, nationally and internationally". She became "hooked" on Encaustic Art after watching a demonstration at the BBKA Spring Convention

In 1990, June attended the Federation of Irish Beekeepers Convention held in Co. Meath each July where she holds four workshops on encaustic Art. She is looking forward to getting us hooked too.

Ted Hulbert Ted Hulbert trained as an Electronic Engineer, and worked for one of the Philips' Organisations first in quality control, then as Plant Technical Education & Training Officer. In the early 1960s he moved into technical College Teaching. Early in 1970's he saw an exhibition of Beekeeping, at, of all places The Ideal Home Exhibition. Living in London, he could see no way of keeping bees in a busy suburb. In 1975 he and his wife moved to Cumbria, where he went to University for a year and obtained a Diploma in Agricultural Engineering. His wife, besides starting a new job, attended a beginners Beekeeping Course at the local college. Coming down from University he promptly acquired two hives, so began his interest in bees, and he resumed teaching this time in a secondary school.

He retired at 58 to become a full time beekeeper, building his apiaries to twenty five hives. Health problems forced him to give up active bee keeping after fifteen years. Soon after returning from college he attended a course on Pollen appreciation, so began his interest in microscopy. He maintains an active interest in bee keeping and in Microscopy. He is currently a member of the Quexet Microscopical Society, the Manchester Microscopical and Natural History Society and The Postal Microscope Society.
