## Dementia Friendly Garden in Springhead Park, Rothwell

A dementia friendly garden, the first of its kind, has opened in Rothwell. With support from local Councillors, the idea for the garden came from Peter Smith, the founder of the Rothwell Tea Cosy Memory Café.

The dementia garden has been specifically designed to provide an outdoor welcoming environment for people affected by dementia. The garden offers a pleasant space with dementia friendly features for people of all ages and backgrounds to visit and enjoy the outdoors.

The weather was terrible for the opening of the garden on 17th May but that did nothing to dampen spirits!! Around 40% of the total costs for the garden were provided by local community members (including Bob the Plumber!!), with other contributions coming from various organisations.

The **Outer South Community Committee** contributed a wonderful **£10,000** towards the overall £35,000 costs.



## Protecting Our Children Online!!

The **Community Committee** has been looking into how we can help schools to educate all of the children in the Outer South area about how they stay safe online, as this is a priority for a lot of parents in the area.

Working with our partners at the local policing team and the school Clusters, we would like to have sessions available for all children of around Year 5 and 6 age (and perhaps older).

We are lucky that the Outer South Policing Team has a number of officers who have been trained in how to deliver this information in an interesting and engaging way, as they can offer sessions for both children and parents (separately). The **Community Committee** therefore is working with clusters to offer this to all schools. It could also be done at youth groups or similar.

Please speak to your school or youth group if this is something you are interested in and ask them to contact the Outer South Police Working Area Team or Targeted Services Leader if they are able to accommodate a session!!

## Sanitary Donation Stations

Having seen national research that some young women are missing days from school each month due to not having access to essential sanitary products, the **Community Committee's Children's Champion, Cllr Bruce** has been looking into how we can ensure this doesn't affect young women in the Outer South.

Working with the group 'Freedom 4 Girls' the **Community Committee** is going to establish Sanitary Towel Donation Stations at key locations in the Outer South so that people can donate unopened packs of sanitary towels for distribution to schools, women's refuges and foodbanks. **Please look out for them in a supermarket near you and remember to donate if at all possible!!**
