Right Now: SPUC Annual White Flower Appeal:

Permission has been given by the Archdiocese and parishes are already signed up. **Can you ask your Parish Priest if they would have a White Flower event to benefit SPUC Scotland?** Any date works – just ask your PP and I'll get you the materials. This is the major fund raiser for Scotland's biggest pro-life group and an excellent event for the whole parish.



28 December: Holy Innocents' Mass – Save the Date:

Archbishop Cushley will say Mass for the Pro Life community on **Friday, 28th December, 12 noon in the Gillis Centre**. If you're at home over Christmas this is always a good event, a key Pro Life feast and very much part of the Christmas tradition. We have refreshments afterwards & it's always nice to chat with fellow pro-lifers over a cuppa. I have some Cava left from the Launch – shall we?

Lent – 40 Days for Life:
