#### **General Competition Conditions:**

- 1. BEACON GAMES and Leeds Open shall be competed under the Laws, Rules, Regulations and Championship Conditions of the Amateur Swimming Association.
- 2. The individual event conditions may not include any conditions, which affect the event conditions of another discipline.
- 3. All competitors shall have been registered members of the club under whose name they compete for at least 60 days prior to the first day of the competition.

#### Conditions

- 1. The competition shall be held annually, under FINA/ASA/BEACON GAMES conditions
- 2. The promotion of the Competition shall be the responsibility of the BEACON GAMES host programme. It shall, in partnership with the Talent Development Officer for Synchro decide any matter arising that is not covered by these conditions.
- 3. The event organisation shall be the responsibility of the allotted host Beacon Programme approved by the Talent Development Officer for Synchro.
- 4. All officials shall be qualified and on the ASA Synchronised Swimming Licensed Officials List (where applicable).
- 5. All Beacon clubs are responsible for appointing judge(s) as set out by the host Beacon programme and are responsible for the expenses of the judge(s).
- Competitors will enter as a Regional Beacon Programme for the BEACON GAMES and/or as an ASA affiliated club or nation/ home country in the Open category. The maximum number of entrants per Beacon programme is 15.
- 7. The promoters may in the case of entry numbers/ time constraints refuse Open entries on a first come first served basis.
- 8. BEACON GAMES events include:
  - a) 12&U figures
  - b) 13-15 figures
  - c) Regional Beacon Programme and England Talent team routine displays (not scored)

OPEN events include:

- a) 12&U figures, Free Team
- b) 13-15 figures, Free Team
- c) 15-18 figures, Free Team

9. Order of appearance for routines will be by container draw.

10. A team shall consist of not less than four (4) nor more than eight (8) for free routines

11. The names of the swimmers competing in the free teams must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes of the figure results being available. Changes after this time may only be made in the case of sudden illness or accident of the competitor, and if the reserve is ready to compete without delaying the event.

12. If the lack of a reserve reduces the team size to less than four (4) the team shall be disqualified.

13. Failure to notify the Referee of substitution and/or scratches shall result in disqualification.

14. Final results for Teams are based on 50% average figure score and 50% Team routine score

#### **Entry Qualifications**

The Age Groups shall be as outlined below

- 1. Age as at midnight on the 31<sup>st</sup> December in the year of competition
- 2. Competitors to enter figures and one team only. Swimmers may also take part in a Regional Beacon programme/ England Talent team display.
- 3. 9-12 year olds will have a minimum of skill 1 for figures and team
- 4. 13-15 year olds will have a minimum of skill 2 for figures and team
- 5. 15-18 year olds will have a minimum of skill 3 for figures and team
- 6. Swimmers who are 15 years old may swim in either the 13-15 age group OR the 15-18 age group
- 7. Qualifying skills must have been attained by the closing date for the competition.

## Swim wear

#### **FINA rules shall apply**

GR5.1 The swimwear (swimsuit, cap and goggles) of all competitors shall be in good moral taste and suitable for the individual sports disciplines and not to carry any symbol which may be considered offensive.

GR5.2 All costumes shall be non-transparent

GR5.4 The Referee of a competition has the authority to exclude any competitor(s) whose costume and/or body symbols do not comply with this rule.

SS13.5 In Routines the swimwear must conform to GR5 and be appropriate for synchronised swimming competitions. The use of accessory equipment, goggles or additional clothing is not permitted unless required by medical reason. Nose clips or plugs may be worn.

SS13.5.1 In the event that the referee thinks a competitor(s) swimwear does not conform to GR5 and SS13.5, the competitor(s) will not be permitted to compete until changing into appropriate swimwear.

#### Figures

All competitors must wear a one-piece plain black suit and plain white cap. Goggles and nose clips may be worn. Jewellery is not allowed. Nail varnish must be removed.

Each age group shall perform the compulsory group plus one group drawn from groups as stated. The figures will be drawn on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July and communicated via email.
