**Parents Code of Conduct**



As a parent:

- I will deliver and collect my child promptly to club sessions informing club coaches if there are problems with this
- I will ensure my child has the appropriate equipment for each session
- I will encourage my child to follow their own code of conduct rules respecting all other coaches and swimmers
- I will behave responsibly as a spectator at training / competitions treating other swimmers/ coaches/ committee members and other parents with due respect
- I will ensure I do not use inappropriate language within the club environment.
- I will show appreciation and support for my child and all the team members
- I will support the club coaches and committee appropriately and raise any concerns in the appropriate manner.
- I will complete and return the Medical Information Form as requested by the club detailing any health conditions / concerns relevant to my child on the consent form. Any changes to my child's state of health will be reported to the coach prior to coaching sessions.
- I will ensure up to date contact details are available to coaches.
- Most of all I will help my child to enjoy the sport and achieve to the best of their ability

The club will undertake to:

- Ensure good child safeguarding guidelines are followed to keep your child safe
- Ensure that all activities are properly supervised by coaches and consent is obtained for any outside activities previously agreed.
- Inform you if your child is ill and ensure their wellbeing until you are able to collect.

As a parent you have a right to:

- Make a complaint to the club if you feel the club or a member of the club is not acting according to ASA / club rules and regulation. Details on how to complain are available from the Welfare Officer.
- Make a complaint on behalf of your child to the ASA Office of Judicial Administration
