01 February 2014

04 February 2014

On site much of the activity was focused on the outside roads and car parks, whilst the remedial work to the upper flooring continued internally. What was needed is a spell of drier weather ("and so say all of us!") to enable the ground works to be progressed at a faster rate.

The access and car park roads were virtually finished and the final road connection was being made to Harrier Lane. The ground-working team was trying to catch up on delays caused by the appalling weather and internally finishing touches were being made.

Externally the steps up to the patio from the lower car park were complete and hand rails and safety rails are under construction with a safe children's' area being installed next to the patio.



21 February 2014

The flooring issues have been sorted and final snagging and equipment installations were being made.



24 February 2014

Landscaping was a problem as the ground remains waterlogged, but this can be dealt with at a later date, the important thing being to get the building fully functional and open for business.....
