Translate the following into Spanish:

What do you want?

I would like two white coffees, a sparkling water, a beer and a lemonade, please.

Can we eat here?

Bring us the menu, please.

I want a cheese sandwich, Maria wants a ham sandwich, Pedro wants an omelette and we want a portion of chips to share.

Do you want anything more?

Bring us more bread, please.

What is the weather today?

It is sunny but it is windy also.

Tomorrow, it is going to be cold.

We have a reservation for two double rooms.

I want a twin room with views of the mountains, please.

How much does it cost per week?

The shower doesn't work

The room isn't clean.

Can I have more towels, please?

Where is the swimming pool?

How can I help you?

I am just looking.

Do you want it?

I'm not sure.

Can I pay with a credit card?

Can I see your passport?

Can you give me a bag and a receipt?

Does this suit me?

It is too small? (*note mistake in handout!!*)

Can I try it?

It is too dear.

Have you anything cheaper?

I want to change money

How much do you want to change?

Fifty pounds.

I would like to change these travellers cheques.

The cash machine has swallowed my card.

I don't feel well.

Where does it hurt?

It hurts here.

My head/ stomach/ throat hurts

I have a headache/ stomach ache/ sore throat.

Have you anything for a headache?

I have diarrhoea.

Have you anything for sunburn?

You need to put on this cream.

You need to take these pills after eating.

I wake up at six o'clock, get up and shower. I eat breakfast then dress. I leave the house at 7.30 and arrive at work at 8.15. I work until 1.00 and then have lunch. I return to work at 2.00 and work until 5.00. I return home at 6.00 and eat dinner at 8.00.

At the moment, George is happy

We are in the studio that is in Scotland. We are English.

The ticket is £25

I think that Spanish is a very easy language

Can we go to the cinema?

I return home at 6 o'clock every day.

He has blue eyes and brown hair. He wears a red shirt and black trousers.

I spoke with my mother.

Yesterday, I sang a song, danced with my friend and spoke Spanish.

Did you sing or did you dance or did you speak Spanish yesterday?

Two years ago, they sang with Madonna.

Last week, you cooked dinner for me. I liked it a lot.

Yesterday, I bought bread at the supermarket. Now, I am eating bread and butter. Tomorrow, I am going to dine at a restaurant.

What did you do yesterday?

I went to the cinema to see Captain America.

The shop opened at 8 o'clock yesterday and the assistant sold me a litre of milk.

I went up the stairs and saw Maria in the room.

Have a try at translating the text in the handout entitled “Extract from Edinburgh tourist leaflet in Spanish” in to English. This is “proper” Spanish and has not been produced for educational purposes. Give it a try – try to get the sense if not a literal translation. Avoid using Google or other computerised translation aids – just use what you know plus a dictionary.
