WELCOME BACK - REOPENING OF CHURCHES FOR PRIVATE PRAYER

St Teresa's Church will be open for PRIVATE PRAYER from Monday 6th July 10am – 11:30am and again on Wednesday 8th July 6pm – 7:30pm and a further time on Thursday 9th July 2pm – 4pm (this is the time for the Food Bank Donation).

Following Government and Diocesan Protocols there are several measures and procedures that need to be followed:

Stewards have been given training.

Sanitation of Hands on entry and exit...One Way System of Entry and Exit.

Stewarding to Pew...No touching or kissing of statues...Candles to be lit from another candle (i.e. no matches or match boxes to be touched or used).

When capacity is reached there will be a one in and one out system operated....the **capacity is 60**.

Anyone who appears to have symptoms of COVID will be asked not to enter the Church at that time.

The Church will have been deep cleaned and will be sanitised after each session and during if necessary.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation...Let us continue to pray together as God's Family. It is hope that in time more churches will be able to open for Private Prayer and for Mass.

VOLUNTEERS STILL WANTED TO SUPPORT THE REOPENING OF CHURCHES

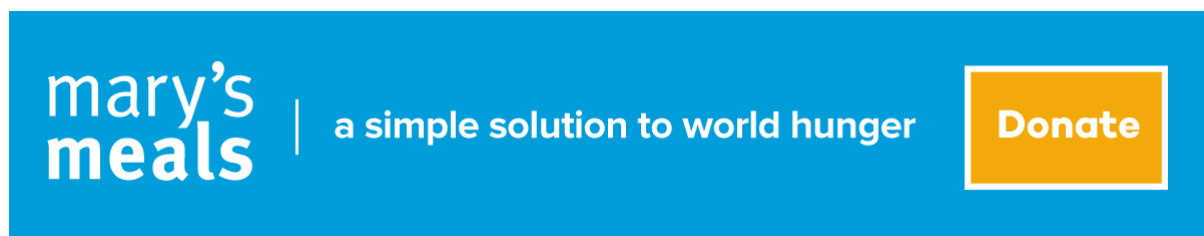
We have begun preparations for a gradual re-opening of our churches for private prayer with the hope to opening for Mass soon.
