MINUTES OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE OF KEEVIL PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

The Planning Committee Meeting commenced with Councillor Banfield in the Chair.

1. To Consider Planning Application KV16/03900/FUL – Pyatts Farm, 101 The Strand, Keevil

The application was discussed. Councillors had no objection to the application but asked the Clerk to pass on to the WC Planning Department the following comments:

- Councillors are concerned that the size and scale of this development is out of proportion for the usage described i.e. there was little sign of any agricultural activity.
- If access to this site increases as a result of the planned equestrian activity then there could be traffic problems. Access to the site via Great Hinton is through very narrow lanes and access via the A361 is on a dangerous bend where there have been a number of fatal accidents.

2. Response to WC Planning Department

Councillor Hunter proposed that WC Development Control be informed that Keevil Parish Council had no objection to Planning Application KV16/03900/FUL. The proposal was seconded by Councillor Kevan. The proposal was carried unanimously. The Chairman instructed the Clerk to write to Wiltshire Council accordingly along with the comments mentioned above.
