Charges for use of MADCC equipment.

- The Club Committee believes that annual subscriptions should be used to cover the regular club expenditure which benefits all members and that, where possible, club equipment should be largely self-funding through a "pay-for-use" approach. The Committee believes this is the arrangement which is fairest to all members.
- The Committee believes that members who are committed to the sport should buy their own equipment, but recognises that this is not always appropriate.
- The club fleet of boats and accessory equipment offer a valuable resource for; introducing new entrants to paddlesport,
 - broadening the experience of club members through low cost access to different types of craft and paddlesport disciplines,
 - strengthening the skills development of club coaches by allowing practice in a range of craft.
- Charges are made for the use of club equipment in order to cover wear and tear and to help the club towards the repair and/or replacement costs.
- Charges apply at all club sessions, and for all private use.
- Charges do not apply when members are representing MADCC at interclub events, such as Hasler races
- Charges do not apply to club coaches when they use club equipment for instructing at club sessions.
- Charges do not apply to club coaches, or trainee coaches for use of equipment to support their coaching
 development and improve personal paddling skills. Such use should not interfere with availability of equipment
 for usual coaching sessions (for example, Monday evenings), and in situations where equipment is taken on loan
 the usual rental fees will apply.

- The VHF radio is for use only by those holding the relevant operator's licence.
- Equipment users are requested to pay the relevant charge either to a club representative who is collecting fees at a club session, or direct to the Treasurer.
- Where appropriate, advance booking of equipment should be made through the Equipment Officer.
