10 Champion Ideas

- 1. Collecting champion** Write to your local council, or shopping or leisure centre, to apply for permission and a date to hold a collection. We will provide you with an ID badge and collecting tins.
- 2. Sponsored Champion** You could jump out of a plane (with a parachute!), shave your head, run a marathon, give up chocolate, kick a bad habit, stay silent for a day – or come up with your own challenge!
- 3. Party Champion** Everyone loves a good party, big or small. Charge for entry and add karaoke or silly games for more fun and fundraising!
- 4. Quiz Champion** Ask the manager of your local pub if you can hold a quiz. If they already run a quiz, suggest they hold one to raise funds for North Wales Deaf Association.
- 5. Sports Champion** Hold a sports day for friends and family in your local park and charge for entry to your very own mini Olympics. Prefer team games? Arrange a football, rounders or golf tournament instead.
- 6. Community Champion** Approach local schools and ask them to have a dress-down day, organise a bring-and-buy sale at your local church – or ask shops to place a collection tin by their tills.
- 7. Dinner Party Champion** Host a dinner party and ask people to donate for the privilege of eating your tasty dishes.
- 8. eBay Champion** Have a clear out and sell your unwanted items on ebay and donate a share of the proceeds to North Wales Deaf Association.
- 9. Supermarket Champion** Apply for permission to hold a bag-packing day in your local supermarket. Bring some friends, pick a busy shopping day and get packing for small change.
- 10. Coffee Break Champion** Why not host a coffee morning, afternoon tea or cake sale?
