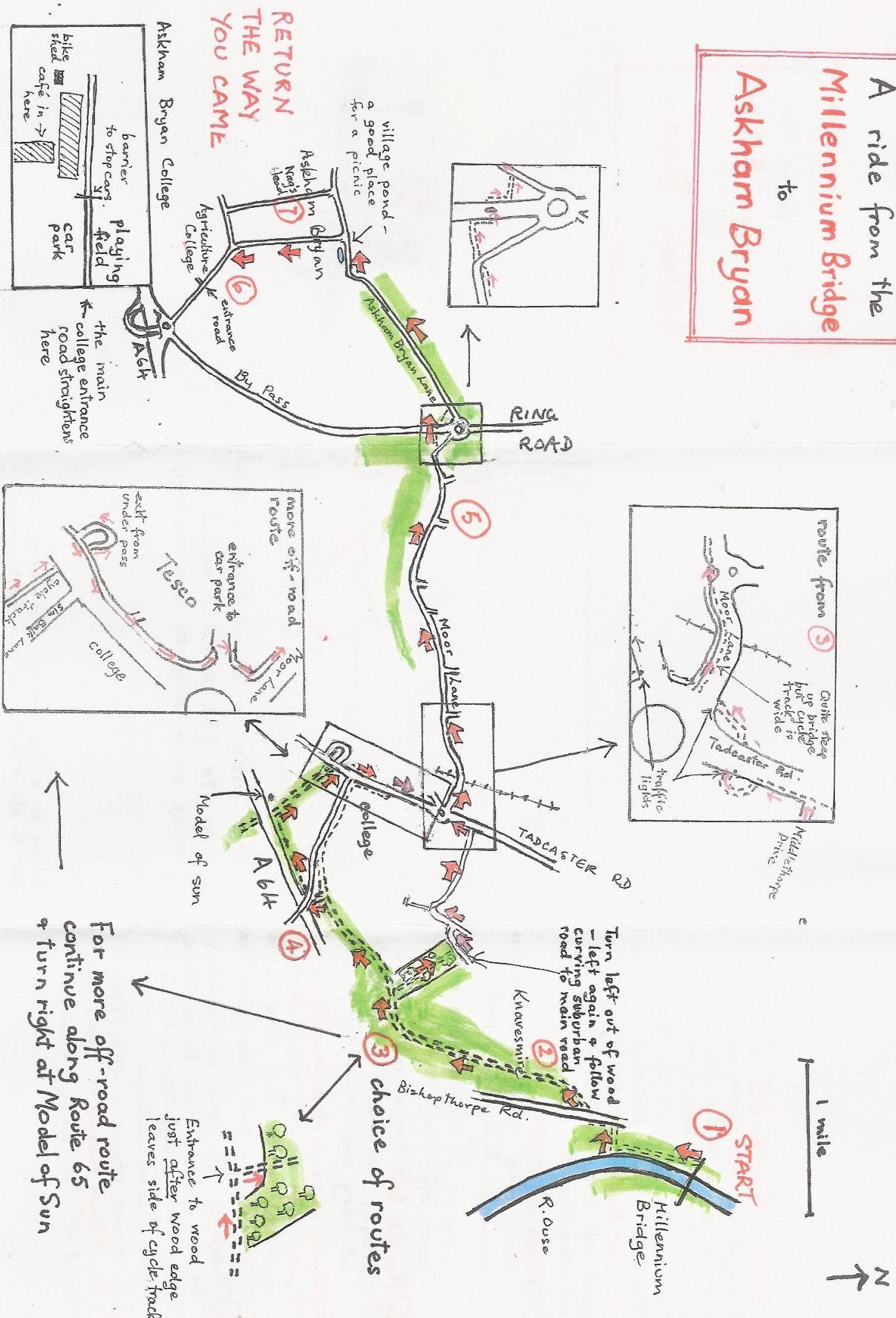
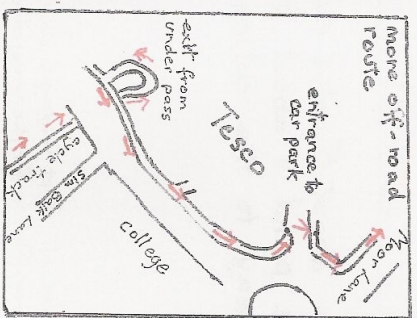
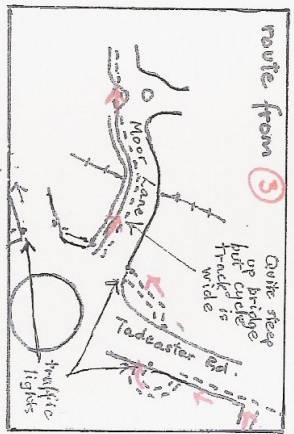
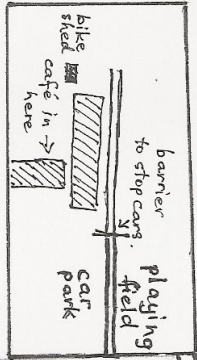


A ride from the Millennium Bridge to Askham Bryan

③ choice of routes

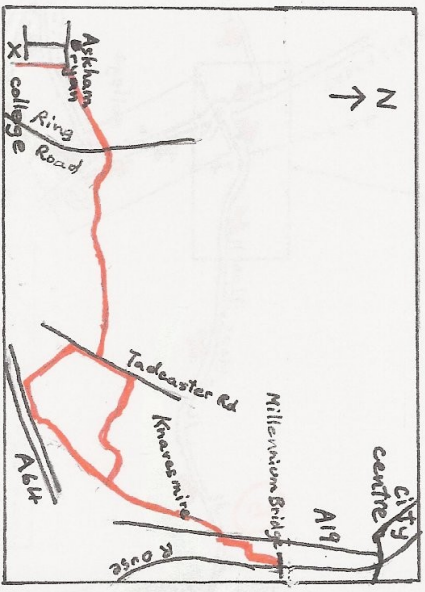
Entrance to wood just after leaves side of cycle track

- ① Follow Route 65 signs alongside the river, up a narrow passage & across the road to the Knaresmire. This route is part of the National Cycle Network (NCN)
- ② A car boot sale makes this part of the Knaresmire busy at weekends.
- ③ Choice of routes
- Knaresmire Wood & suburban roads to Tadcaster Road
or
- continue on Route 65 for a more off-road route.
- ④ Route 65 turns left & will briefly run next to the A64 but very well fenced off from it.
- ⑤ Moor Lane & Askham Bryan Lane are fairly quiet & the crossing over the ring road is good — but take your time
- ⑥ There is no cafe in Askham Bryan but, during term time, there is a cafeteria in the Agricultural College.
- ⑦ The Nag's Head is open for food at 12. (except Mon.)



This ride is about 5 miles each way to the pond & about 6 miles each way to the college
