ILM Level 5 Certificate in Leadership

Course Overview

The Advancing your Leadership Skills course is highlyinteractive and provides excellent coverage of the knowledge, skills and techniques for success as a leader. In challenging times where organisations continue to support the professional development of staff with reduced training budgets, this course provides a cost effective, accredited and high quality training initiative for groups of staff. It is possible for individual local authorities or departments, colleges, schools, training providers or collaborations to have a bespoke programme designed specifically for their own staff. The six-day programme will equip participants with the skills and confidence to progress and participants will also have the opportunity to achieve the Institute of Leadership and Management (ILM) Level 5 Certificate in Leadership qualification. The qualification is designed to help individuals have a better understanding of themselves as leaders, and develop the skills to plan and develop their own leadership performance. Learners must attain a total of 21 credits to achieve the certificate and the qualification is structured into 2 mandatory units:

- Assessing Your Own Leadership Capability and Performance and
- Improving Own Leadership Performance Through Action Learning.

With the success of education providers and local authority departments being very much dependent on the quality, responsiveness and skills of middle managers this leadership programme has been developed for and specifically targets aspiring leaders and managers in these sectors.

It is designed for those who are seeking to develop their leadership skills, get better results from their teams and prepare themselves to take on more responsibility.
