This application is scheduled to be decided by the Members of Stroud District Council's Development Control Committee on Tuesday 14th July 2015. Any comments on this application will be received up until the meeting. However if you wish the Officers report to reflect your comments please ensure they are received by Stroud District Council by the 19th June 2015. Comments should be made to planning and the reference is S.15/0971/OUT. This can be viewed via www.stroud.gov.uk. The previous application for up to 59 houses at this location has been registered for appeal. To date there are no further details.

#### Stroud District Council (SDC) Local Plan Public Examination

This has resumed and is being held the Council Chamber at Ebley Mill, the timetable and agenda can be accessed on the District Council Website <u>www.stroud.gov.uk</u>. Kingswood Parish Council has put forward evidence and will be part of Stage 2 proceedings in connection with the Settlement Hierarchy. This will begin at 10.00am on Thursday **28th May**. On Thursday 4th June, the various Town/Village clusters will be examined for appropriateness. Furthermore, if the inspector decides that there is insufficient development in the plan or that some of the sites are not deliverable he will look at the omission sites. One of these is the Cloverlea Barn site at Wickwar Road. This site has not yet been subject to public consultation for inclusion in the Local plan. However, the inspector wishes to hear from the applicants and SDC on all the omission sites. All comments on this will be placed on the SDC examination library under ref PS2/A. The Inspector will hear the evidence on Cloverlea Barn on the **12th June** from 10.00am -2pm. This is a public meeting and the public can attend to observe and listen. There is no public participation. The Clerk will be attending to hear the evidence if anyone wishes to attend she will be happy for the company. Please contact her to make arrangements. If this site is selected then it will have to go out for public consultation and you will be able to comment. However, this is separate from any planning application that may be submitted for this site.
