## Village Design Statement - The Parish Council needs your Help to complete A Village Design Statement.

This will describe Kingswood Parish as it is today and highlight the qualities valued by its residents. The Statement has to be written by residents so that local knowledge, views and ideas may contribute to the future, and the high quality of their environment. The aim is to ensure that further development and change, are based on a considered understanding of the villages' past and present. This will contribute positively to a sustainable future for the Parish and protect and enhance its unique and special characteristics. A Design Statement will be arranged in sections that will typically include; Settlements; Landscape and Wildlife; Buildings; Highways and Economy, with each containing descriptive text followed by a series of guidelines. These guidelines will represent the key points that users of the document are encouraged to take into account at an early stage when planning or implementing development or change within the Parish. The document may also contain "Local View" entries, which reflect the views of local residents expressed during any consultation work. The objective is for the Design Statement to be adopted by Stroud District Council as Supplementary Planning Advice.
