MUSIC AT ST MARY'S - Following the rapturously received Music at St. Mary's concert in July, which had sold out months in advance, we have two more concerts to complete our programme for 2014:

Friday 17th October 2014: Amethyst String Ensemble. The performers are all experienced professional musicians, who have been performing, teaching and freelancing in the South West for many years. They give us the rare chance to hear works for larger chamber groups and their programme will include two such masterpieces: the Mozart Clarinet Quintet and Brahms String Sextet in B flat major Op18.

Saturday 13th December: The Saint Cecilia Singers will perform a concert of favourite carols and readings for Christmas. The Saint Cecilia Singers is a chamber choir of enthusiastic and gifted amateur and semi-professional singers. It was founded in 1949, is based in Gloucester and has close links with Gloucester Cathedral. Each year, by long tradition, this choir gives a Christmas concert in the cathedral which is also given in just one other place in Gloucestershire. This year St Mary's is that fortunate location.
