# Wotton under Edge -

It has come to my attention that there has been an increase in money exchange deception and the passing of counterfeit currency.

I would advise that the exchange deception involves a person confusing a cashier via 'quick change' methods by handing over currency and asking for note exchange. The person then changes their mind and asks for the return of the currency. Usually the person deceiving ends up with more money and the person behind the till ends up short. If in doubt, say no.

Counterfeit currency within the area. Again, the note should be checked for a watermark, foils markings should be in place by holding the note up to the light. The general feel of the note should be correct. UV pens can also be used to check the notes.

Even better - along the bottom of the note against the writing and marks is another clever feature. By magnifying this area, you will see the note denomination disguised within the features. This is almost invisible to the eye.

Any further information can be found via the bank of England website. There are suitable downloads available. I am also able to send out various PDF format advice as required.

### Kingswood -

Chestnut Park development -

There have been two incidents of building material thefts from the site.

The dates are reported as the 6th of February and the weekend of the 10th of February. On both occasions, there have been no description and no specific time given. I would however stress that during the weekends and after hours; there should be no persons on the site. I would ask that members of the area call the police 101 and report any suspicious incidents. We will then be able to attend the area and ask those persons to account for actions if necessary.

## General advice when contacting the police -

If reporting a suspicious person or incident the following information is always useful -

Description - Male/Female, Height, approximate age. Hair description or any hats? Clothes in the format of Jackets, Coats, colouring or logo's. Lower body such as trousers, shorts and shoe description.

Any other features such as tattoos, scars, earrings, accents.

Do you know of the person?

Is there more than one person? Are they in a group?

Is there a vehicle involved and what are the registration details? What is the shape and colour of the vehicle?

I would however point out that never put yourselves in any danger. There is also the option of doing nothing when it comes to personal safety.
