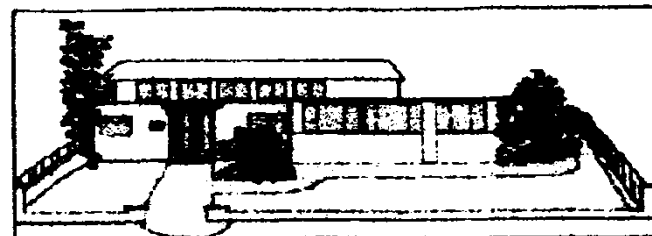

DAVID'S TRIPLE CHALLENGE FOR CHARITY

David Smith has been overwhelmed by the support he has had from so many people during his 'Triple Challenge'. The 3 good causes that are being supported are St. John's Hospice, Wirral, Bloodwise (supporting people suffering from leukaemia and lymphoma) and the Shoebox Appeal at Church. To date £473 across the 3 causes has been promised.

David and son-in-law Rich completed the 28 mile Wirral Bikeathon in 2.5 hours and both really enjoyed the atmosphere of cycling with 1,000 cyclists and meeting Olympic cyclist Chris Boardman at the end of the ride. The Swimathon last Tuesday was successful with 105 consecutive lengths swum (approx. 1.3 miles) in 1 hour 54 minutes.

This was the second part of the Triple Challenge and the challenge that David was a bit anxious about as he is not a keen swimmer!!

The third and final part comes today with the Wirral Coastal Walk (15 miles from Seacombe Ferry to Thurstaston). David is walking with Brenda Brown and wife Anne, the walk is anticipated to take around 4-5 hours. Thank you for all your support.
