A Brief History...

The first CVS was created at the end of the 19th century, and in 1945 the National Association of Councils for Voluntary Service (NACVS) was formed, creating a network of CVS's. Preston CVS is one of the 240+ local CVS's who form this network. In June 2006 NACVS changed its name to the National Association for Voluntary and Community Action (NAVCA).

Preston CVS was first established in 1934 during the depression, with the aim of alleviating some of the needs of the population by harnessing the goodwill in 'social services'.

During its 75 years of establishment, Preston CVS has achieved a number of successes, nurturing new projects and supporting and representing many groups.
