The Parish Council reviewed the documents prepared by Chris Grundy on behalf of the Allotment Working Group. It was agreed that the Council's position is that it does not wish to allow livestock on the allotments and that investigations should be made into the application of local byelaws to prevent such an occurrence.

4. MINERALS AND WASTE DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK

It was agreed not to submit any further comments at this stage (Minerals Options and Waste Vision Consultation) of the process as the Parish Council broadly agrees with the principles set out in the consultation document; however the manner in which these principles are enacted during the planning application process will determine their effect and more importantly impact on this parish.

It is expected that a consultation on potential minerals extraction sites will take place over this summer and this will be of particular interest to this Council as the consultation will relate to proposals for possible future extensions to the Potgate and Hanson's Ripon quarries. It was noted that initial suggestions for potential sites (put forward by developers) are now available to view on North Yorkshire County Council's website; however these are likely to be substantially narrowed down before the public consultation.

It was agreed that the Parish Council wishes to ask North Yorkshire County Council to include it in all future consultations on the Minerals and Waste Development Framework.
